LANDS ACQUISITION ACT 1989 PRE-ACQUISITION DECLARATION

1. Acquisition

In accordance with the Lands Acquisition Act 1989, I am considering the acquisition of the interest in land specified in paragraph 4 for the public purpose in paragraph 5.

2. The acquiring authority

The Commonwealth of Australia is the acquiring authority.

3. The land

This declaration relates to land described as Lot 502 in Deposited Plan 55945 and located in District Nookawarra in the locality of South Murchison approximately 315 km north east of Geraldton and 40 km north of the Boolardy Station homestead in Western Australia. The land is an irregular polygon shape measuring approximately 12803 hectares. A plan of the land is attached.

4. The interest in the land

This declaration relates to the acquisition of an interest under an Indigenous Land Use Agreement within the meaning of the *Native Title Act 1993*, namely:

- the consent of any native title holders to the grant of a leasehold interest in the land (the Crown Lease) by the Western Australian Minister for Lands to the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (CSIRO) established by the *Science and Industry Research Act 1949*. Consent to the grant of the Crown Lease includes consent to any extension, re-grant or renewal of it;
- confirmation by any native title holders of the validity of an Investigation
 Licence granted by the Western Australian Minister for Lands to CSIRO over
 the land;
- the consent of any native title holders to the doing of all things ancillary to the Project (as described in paragraph 7 below); and
- the consent of any native title holders to all acts, matters and things reasonably
 necessary for the grant of the Crown Lease to CSIRO by the Western
 Australian Minister for Lands and the acquisition of the Crown Lease by
 CSIRO in accordance with the Lands Acquisition Act 1989 or any extension,
 re-grant or renewal of the Crown Lease.

5. The public purpose

The public purpose of the acquisition is astronomical observations by CSIRO and incidental activities.

6. Suitability for development for use for a public purpose

The land appears to be suitable for development for use for the public purpose described in paragraph 5.

7. Particulars of the proposed development for use

The land will be developed to enable the Project to be operated and undertaken on the land.

The Project involves radio-astronomy and ancillary works and activities, including radio science studies, to be developed, operated or undertaken within the land described in paragraph 3 above (and proposed to be known as the Murchison Radio Astronomy Observatory (MRO)). It is intended that the Project will include the following named radio-astronomy projects: the Australian Square Kilometre Array Pathfinder project (ASKAP), the Murchison Widefield Array project, the Precision Array to Probe the Epoch of Reionisation project, the Cosmological Reionisation Experiment, and Prep SKA. The Project will also include any other radio-astronomy and ancillary works and activities to be developed, operated or undertaken within the land described in paragraph 3 above (and proposed to be known as the Murchison Radio Astronomy Observatory (MRO)) as determined by CSIRO in consultation with the Australian Square Kilometre Array Coordination Committee. The Project does not include the Square Kilometre Array (SKA) project.

8. Reasons why the land appears to be suitable for the proposed development for use

The land appears to be suitable for the development for use described in paragraph 7 for the following reasons.

An extensive site selection process for establishing the Murchison Radio Astronomy Observatory (MRO) and constructing the Australian Square Kilometre Array Pathfinder project (ASKAP) has been undertaken by CSIRO and the Western Australian government. As a result of that process, the land has been identified as the preferred location for the Murchison Radio Astronomy Observatory (MRO). The land has excellent radio quietness and fulfils other requirements including that it is flat, it is above the floodplain, it is situated sufficiently far from mining activity and it is sufficiently close to other infrastructure such as roads.


